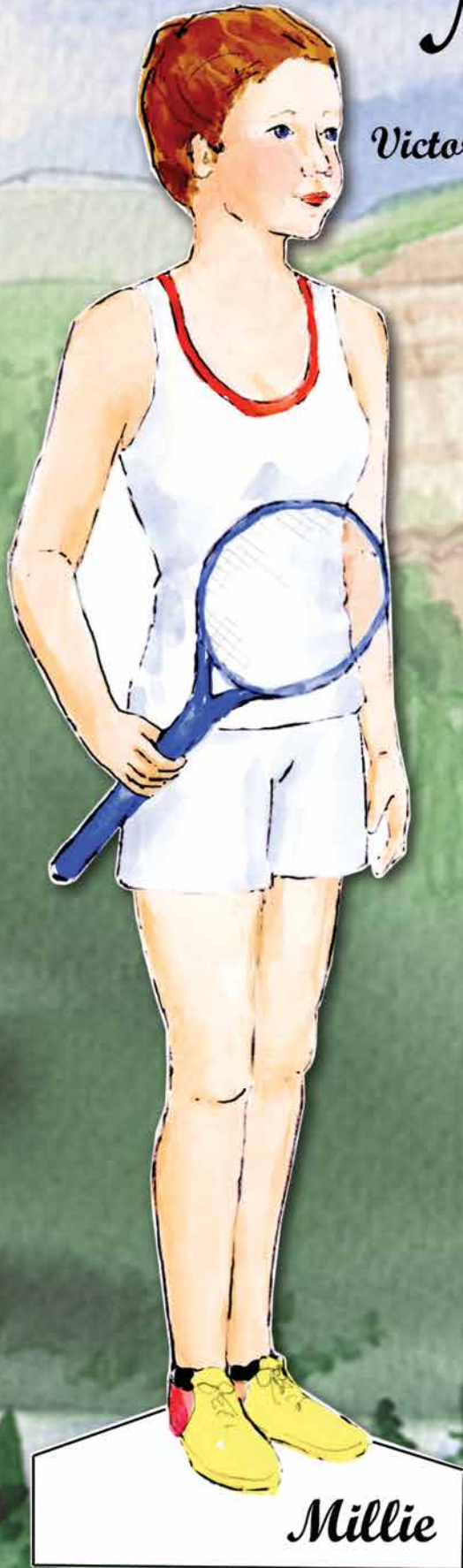

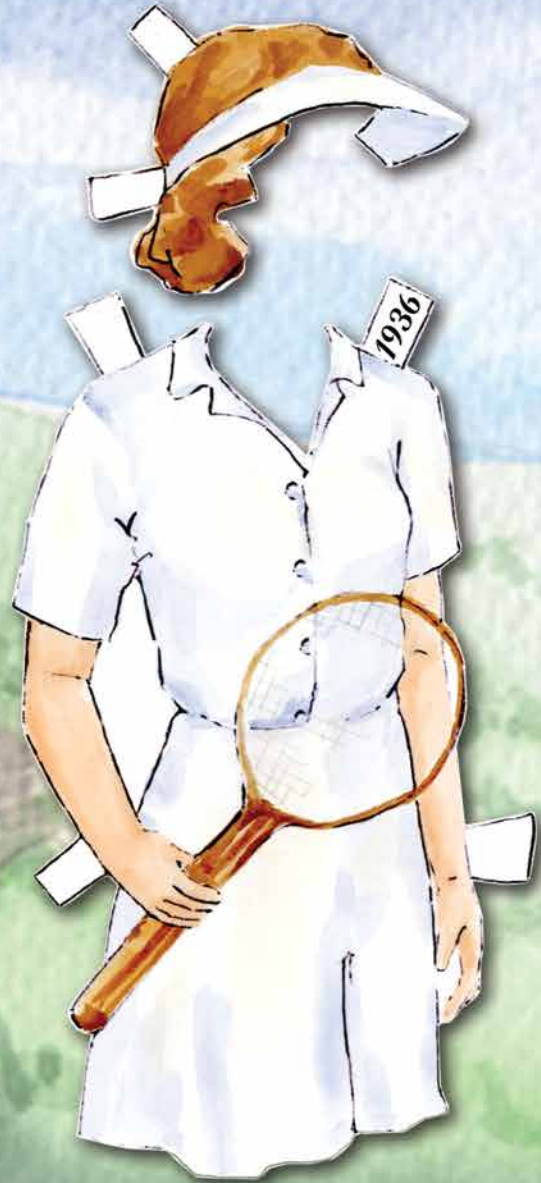
1900

The Olympics were held in Paris, in 1900. The participation by women was limited. They had to abide by strict clothing rules. They had to wear ankle-length dresses with high necks and shoes with a heel.

Women were first allowed to participate in the Olympics in 1900.



In 1908 in London, competitors needed to wear "complete clothing from the shoulder (ie jersey sleeved to the elbows and loose drawers with slips)"



The 1936 Berlin Olympics included more relaxed fitting clothing, including a cotton jersey top. Women could also wear culottes.
