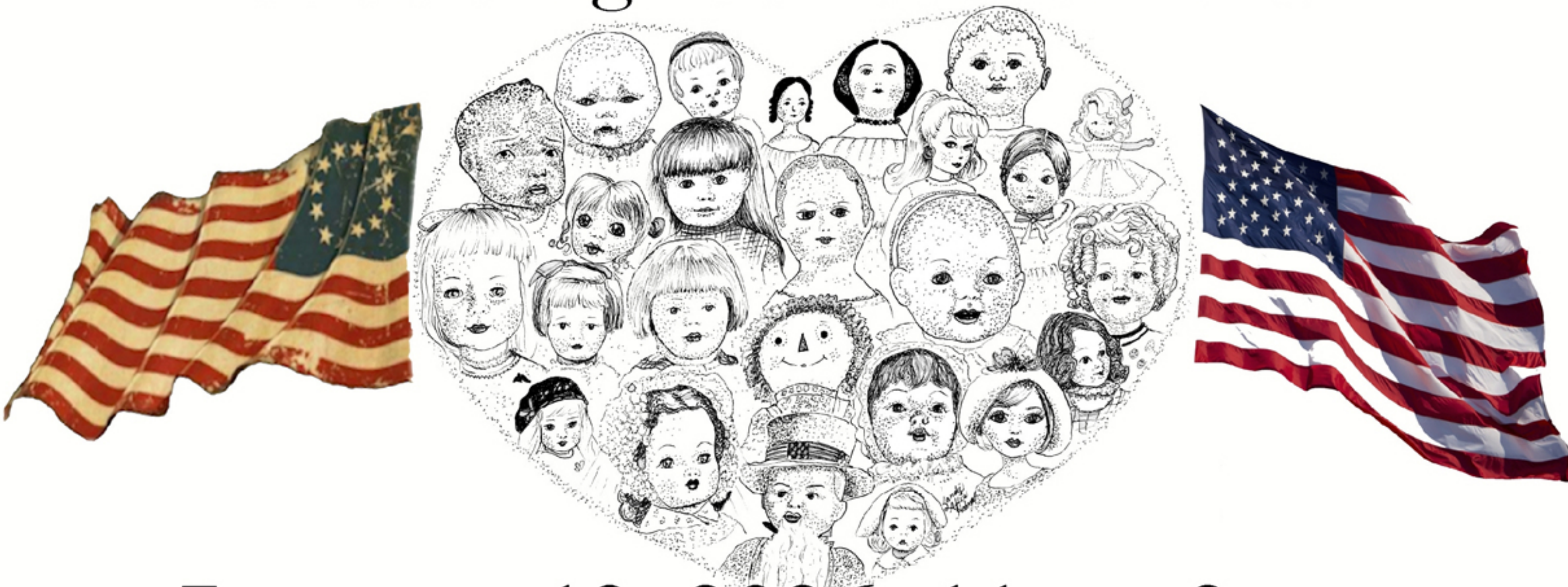

## Directions:

From US Rt. 50 Eastbound:

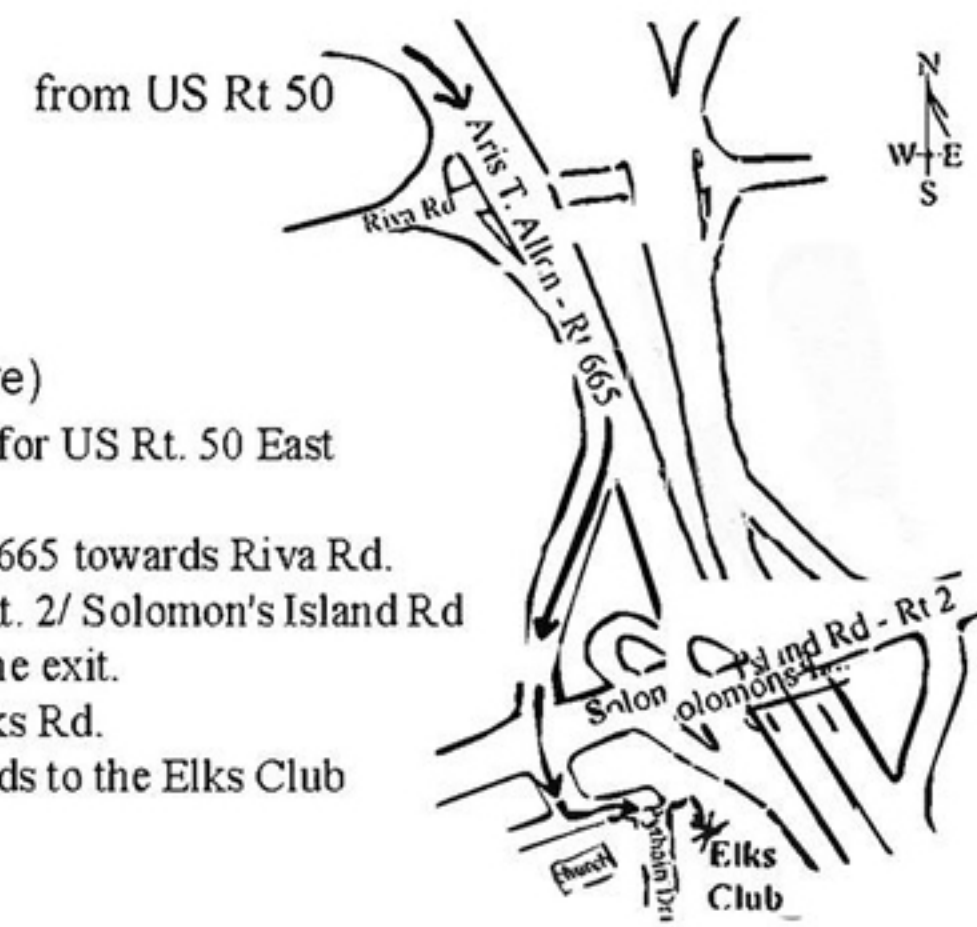
1. Take Rt. 50 east toward Annapolis.
2. Take Exit 22, Aris T. Allen Blvd/ MD Rt. 665 towards Riva Rd.
3. Go about 1 mile and take the exit for Rt. 2/ Solomon's Island Rd.  
USE THE MIDDLE LANE of this 3 lane exit.
4. Go straight across Rt. 2 into Grand Oaks Rd.
5. Take the left fork and go about 100 yards to the Elks Club parking lot.

From US Rt. 50 Westbound:

1. Take Rt. 50 west toward Annapolis.
2. Take Exit 23A, Aris T. Allen Blvd/ MD Rt. 665 towards Riva Rd.
3. Go about 1 mile and take the exit for Rt. 2/ Solomon's Island Rd.  
USE THE MIDDLE LANE of this 3 lane exit.
4. Go straight across Rt. 2 into Grand Oaks Rd.
5. Take the left fork and go about 100 yards to the Elks Club parking lot.

From I 97 (southbound from Baltimore)

1. I 97 ends near Annapolis, take the exit for US Rt. 50 East toward Annapolis.
2. Take the 1st exit, Aris T. Allen/Md Rt. 665 towards Riva Rd.
3. Go about 1 mile and take the exit for Rt. 2/ Solomon's Island Rd  
USE THE MIDDLE LANE of this 3 lane exit.
4. Go straight across Rt. 2 into Grand Oaks Rd.
5. Take the left fork and go about 100 yards to the Elks Club parking lot.

## Doll Competition Categories

American-made play dolls:

1. Cloth: American commercial, pre WWI
2. Cloth: American noncommercial/handmade, pre WWI
3. Wood: Schoenhut dolls from Philadelphia
4. Hard Plastic or Vinyl: 1940s to 1960s doll with mechanism--walker dolls or yes/no dolls or similar (no Barbies)
5. Barbie: Doll with a 'gimmick'--twist-and-turn waist, 'Living' Barbie, growing hair, etc

Political figures and personalities:

1. Any Material: Representations of Betsy Ross or other political figures from American History, other than first ladies. Include manufacturer and character name on card.
2. Any Material: Dolls sold by Kimport or Elsie Clark Krug
3. Any Material: Soldiers from any American war/conflict, pre-2000
4. Any Material: Doll representing any first lady of the US.

Dolls by American Artists:

1. Any Material: NIADA doll artists, including Helen Bullard and similar ([www.niada.org](http://www.niada.org))
2. Any Material: Modern American doll artists
3. Any Material: Doll dressed by an American artist--include name on card. Doll not judged unless also by the clothing maker

Dressed by Owner:

Any Material: Doll dressed by owner as an American political figure.
