## **THE DOLLS OF THE 1920S! Celebrate their centennial decade with us at Dolly Fun Day 2024 on June 29, 2024.**

### ***The afternoon make-it-and-take-it is very exciting!***

In the afternoon, there is a special Half Doll project. Barbara DeVilbiss and Lyna Wiggins attended a dozen or so in-person and online auctions to get you the best buys on antique half dolls. There are complete kits for you to purchase that include all you need to complete your project, each dressed in one-of-a-kind design by Barbara. Since each Half Doll is unique and of Calibri (Body) varying sizes, each of your projects will be your own.

Because of the variation in the Half Dolls, we have chosen the most appropriate finishing for each one. There are 3 finishing choices: (1) a powder puff, (2) a pincushion and (3) on a pole and stand. You will make your personal *choices at the event*. *The price of the project kit is \$25*. Please add that amount to the coupon on the event flyer. Note that the price of these Half Dolls UNFINISHED is often well more than this amount. Because some of our auction lots included Half Dolls of greater value – from \$50 to \$100 or so – we will also have small choice of “premium kits” priced at an extra \$25. You may pay the extra premium on site.
